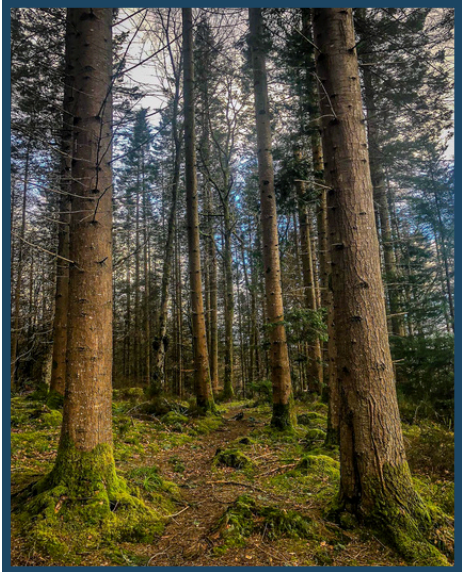

GENERAL HOTEL INFORMATION



Reception is open from 7.30am-10pm, after this if urgent /emergency please ring the bell at the reception desk for 24hour assistance.

You may checkout from 07:30am. if you require an earlier checkout, please settle any outstanding payment the night before and then you can leave your key at reception on your departure in the key box.

Rooms must be vacated by 10:30am. Any damages will be charged to your room account / card

Hotel doors will be locked at night, access is with your White Room Card. (Scan the keypad outside the door, you will hear the door beep then push open).



GUEST INFORMATION

BREAKFAST – A full cooked breakfast is available for £14.99 per guest every morning, served from 7:30 am to 9:30 am. To ensure we're ready for you, simply inform reception if you'd like to enjoy breakfast. We now offer an exciting range of continental options alongside an extensive cooked-to-order breakfast menu.

FIRE DRILL & ASSEMBLY POINT - We ask you to familiarise yourself with the emergency plan on the back of your bedroom door. In the unlikely event of an emergency, alarms will be activated, and we will ask you to evacuate the building via the nearest exit, following the evacuation signs. Staff will be on hand to assist. Please don't be alarmed when we test our system at 11 am every Monday to ensure everything is in working order.

BEDROOMS WITH FIRE EXIT DOORS – The fire exit doors in bedrooms must not be opened, except in an emergency. When doors are opened, an alarm will be set off in the hotel.

FIRST AID – We have First Aid available throughout the hotel at reception and bar area. The nearest defibrillator is located on the wall by Londis (next door).

SMOKING - All areas of the hotel have a strict legal requirement of a non-smoking policy; we have an outside smoking area at the front and rear of the hotel for guests to use. A charge of £150 will be applied to the room account for any guest who violates this rule.

HOUSEKEEPING - Rooms will be serviced during your stay, including fresh towels and toiletries. Please ask at the reception desk for ironing facilities if required. If you do not wish for your room to be serviced, please place the do not disturb sign on your door.
